The course begins with the definition of contextualization and finds in the Bible the guidelines for practicing it in the work of the Kingdom of God. You will learn the theory of contextualizing and you will be given practical tools. You will understand how the Gospel is designed to be contextualized and how you can adapt it to your own church planting situation.

Not everything that Dr. Beck is teaching here is going to fit perfectly to your situation. Listen and absorb the principles, then contextualize the teaching to your area, situation, culture, and language. Seek advice and guidance from God and His Word. Turn to locals you trust or expand your network as described in the teaching to strengthen your confidence in progressing your work. If God sent you, He will lead you!
